

## Financial Information

When you have surgery at the Seattle Surgery Center, you and/or your insurance company will receive billings for three types of services:

- Your surgeon's services,
- Anesthesiology services, and
- ASC facility services.

Your surgeon's services will be billed by Orthopedic Physicians Associates (OPA), a division of Proliance Surgeons. For questions regarding this bill, please call OPA at (206) 386-2600.

Anesthesia services will be billed by U.S. Anesthesia Partners (USAP). For questions regarding this bill, please call USAP at (206) 625-0578.

You will be billed for the facility services provided by Seattle Surgery Center. If you have any questions about the facility fee, please call us at (206) 382-1021.

## Payment

We require payment of your deductible, co-payment, and co-insurance at the time of surgery. We accept cash, checks (\$500<), debit, and all major credit cards. For procedures that are not covered by insurance and for patients who do not have medical insurance, we require full payment (100%) at the time of surgery. Please call our office prior to your surgery date if special payment arrangements are necessary.

## Insurance

Many same-day surgical procedures are covered by standard medical insurance and we participate with many insurance plans. However, you should call your insurance company prior to your surgery date to verify that the procedure is covered to be performed at Seattle Surgery Center and to understand the amount of coverage for your procedure. As a courtesy prior to the date of surgery, Seattle Surgery Center will verify patient insurance coverage and benefits for patients and will make every effort to communicate this information to the Responsible Party before the surgery date.
